Through this CBA, students research and investigate the domain in which the project is situated and present their findings graphically through any appropriate graphical media. Applied Technology (required)	3 weeks	CBA 2 Student self-analysis and evaluation: students will engage in, and document the three areas of activity which contribute to the generation of their evidence of learning and achievement: 1.
