Items that parents / guardians need to purchase are highlighted in yellow. Students are likely to have these already.






Note: As part of the Junior Cycle Schoolbooks Scheme the following will be provided by the school





- Any additional English novel or play

- 12 copybooks (mixture of A4 maths, A4 soft copies and small copies)






We note that a lot of copies will continue to be used throughout the 3 year Junior Cycle and may not need to be replaced (Depending on the subject).
